We are prepared to provide referring physicians and their patient computer generated reports and photographs immediately following the examination. In addition, the close association of Gastroenterologists and the Radiology Department's multi-detector, helical CT scanner assures prompt and thorough evaluations.

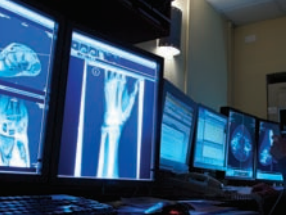
Procedures we perform include:

- Esophagogastroduodenoscopy (EGD) Upper Endoscopy – to evaluate causes of numerous symptoms including abdominal pain, dysphagia (swallowing difficulty), bleeding, nausea, and vomiting; to obtain tissue samples and to assess for infections associated with ulcer disease and stomach cancer
- Colonoscopy – to examine the lining of the colon. To screen for and remove precancerous growths and to diagnose forms of infectious and non-infectious colitis (inflammation).
- Endoscopic Retrograde Cholangiopancreatography (ERCP) – to examine the ducts of the gallbladder, pancreas, and liver and to remove bile duct stones, treat pancreatitis and obstructions due to cancer.
- Bronchoscopy – to examine the trachea and bronchi to assess for abnormalities of the lung and to perform biopsies as indicated.

New York Downtown Hospital offers comprehensive medical imaging services through the Department of Radiology. Recent technological acquisitions include a GE 64-slice VCT scanner, a 1.5 Tesla MRI, a fleet of state-of-the-art ultrasound units, and a DEXA scanner for bone densitometry. Through the Women's Health Center at the New York Downtown Wellness and Prevention Center, we perform a full range of breast imaging including digital mammography, ultrasound, MRI, and image-guided biopsies.

All examinations and reports are stored on an electronic picture archiving and communications system, which can be accessed conveniently by referring physicians from their offices.

Board-certified New York-Presbyterian Hospital / Weill Cornell Medical Center radiologists serve on the full-time staff at New York Downtown Hospital, oversee the provided services, and interpret all imaging exams. These highly-trained experts are general radiologists with subspecialty training in MRI and body imaging, neuroradiology, musculoskeletal imaging, interventional radiology, and women's imaging. They lead a complement of licensed and registered nurses and imaging technologists.

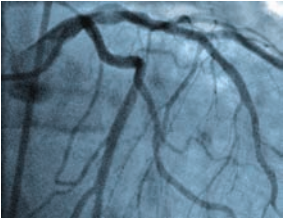

The Center for Cardiovascular Health offers a complete range of non-invasive testing in a variety of disciplines, utilizing the very latest clinical equipment to perform state-of-the-art 4-D echocardiography, 64 slice cardiac computed tomography angiography, coronary calcium scoring, testing for both peripheral arterial and venous disease. Additionally, a full range of stress testing modalities is available in our I.C.A. accredited non-invasive cardiovascular testing center.

The Department of Orthopaedic Surgery is a major clinical department at New York Downtown Hospital. New York Downtown Hospital orthopaedic surgeons perform over 3,000 inpatient and outpatient surgical procedures each year in hospital operating rooms. These include adult reconstructive orthopaedic surgery, primary and revision joint replacement of the hip and knee, ambulatory and complex spinal surgery, foot and ankle surgery, shoulder and elbow surgery, surgery of the hand and wrist, orthopaedic oncologic surgery, surgical treatment of fractures and other orthopaedic trauma, as well as a large variety of arthroscopic and sports medicine procedures.

The orthopaedic surgery faculty practice is located on the eighth floor of the hospital and provides comprehensive orthopaedic care. Orthopaedic surgeons in all orthopaedic specialties are readily available to see patients in outpatient consultation and follow up care in a state-of-the-art office facility. An outpatient physical and occupational therapy center is available on site.

The Department of Orthopaedic Surgery at New York Downtown Hospital is an ACGME approved residency training site in orthopaedic surgery as an integrated component of a rotating orthopaedic surgical residency training program. Orthopaedic surgical residents in all years of training rotate at New York Downtown Hospital.

Orthopaedic surgical conferences are held each weekday throughout the academic year and include lectures by attending and resident staff and a monthly morbidity and mortality conference. There are ongoing departmental performance improvement programs including quality assurance and continuing graduate medical education, as well as an active clinical research program.

Hospitalists are physicians specially trained in the delivery of inpatient care. Working on behalf of the participating referring physicians, hospitalists deliver, coordinate, and oversee all aspects of patient care in the hospital setting. Referring physicians are fully informed of their patients' clinical management in the hospital and receive a comprehensive healthcare summary, together with laboratory, radiology and relevant test results for each patient upon discharge. Physicians will receive this information within 48 hours of patient discharge. When patients are discharged, they return to the care of their referring physician, who then receives a comprehensive discharge summary of the patient's hospital course.

The service is available on a voluntary, case-by-case basis and can even be used to accommodate an extended sabbatical, vacation, or other personal leave of absence.

Candido Anaya, MD, is Chief of the Division of Hospital Medicine at New York Downtown Hospital. Like Dr. Anaya, all of the hospitalists in the Downtown Hospital program are dedicated to working closely with the participating referring physicians to provide excellent medical care to their patients. The Wellness & Prevention Center's objective is disease prevention and the maintenance of optimum health for all in the community. The most advanced diagnostic and screening tools will be used to develop individual assessments and treatment plans to prevent or reduce the severity of disease. Access to excellent primary care is essential to long-term health, and New York Downtown Hospital's unique facility and programs will be the right answer for patients when early detection and intervention can affect outcome.

Each patient will have a preliminary work-up performed by a Primary Care physician. Trained in a broad range of disease types, physicians will complete a formal medical history and perform a comprehensive physical. Testing will follow evidence-based clinical protocols that are age and gender specific. Clinical findings will be developed into individual patient medical profiles with customized risk assessments and recommended treatment plans.

The Breast Center offers state of the art digital mammography, breast ultrasound and breast MRI for the early detection and management of breast disease. Patient specific approaches to treatment and recovery will be developed in consultation with the patient.

The Moody Foundation Center for Cardiovascular Health will focus on the prevention of heart and vascular disease through early identification, as well as implementation of therapeutic lifestyle changes and risk factor modification. Cardiac specialists at the Center have access to the latest clinical equipment to perform detailed lipid analysis, state-of-the-art 4-D echocardiography, and 64 slice cardiac computed tomography angiography for the early detection of sub-clinical heart disease. A full range of stress testing modalities is also available.

At the Preventive Health Center it is our goal to provide a world class diagnostic and symptom management program which will result in minimizing the impact of illness through our focus on prevention. Your personal physician will guide you through every step of the process, from suggesting age-and gender-specific diagnostic procedures to collaborating with you in developing a personalized wellness plan. You may choose to have your Center physician coordinate all of your medical care by acting as your primary care doctor — whether you live or work in Lower Manhattan.

Our services in the Preventive Health Center include: Pulmonary health, including COPD; Cardiovascular assessment and treatment; Primary Care; Osteoporosis management; Endocrinology (diabetes and endocrine abnormalities); and Travel Medicine.

At the Women's Health Center, specialists focus on the prevention and early detection of disease, and develop personalized recommendations for a healthy lifestyle. They provide gynecologic evaluation, early cancer detection and follow-up. Specialists also develop management plans for incontinence, pelvic organ prolapse, chronic pelvic pain, and menopause. Screening for osteoporosis is also available.

The Center is designed for the convenience of the patient. Appointments will be scheduled through a Central Call Center to maximize efficiency and reduce waiting times.
